How can I earn FREE Jewelry?

1. Quick Start Program

- a. 6 Jewelry Shows within 45 days of training show = **\$200 retail jewelry certificate**
- b. Add 3 for total of 9 Jewelry Shows within 60 days of training show = **Additional \$100 retail jewelry certificate**
- c. Add 3 for total of 12 Jewelry Shows within 90 days of training show = **Additional \$100 retail jewelry certificate**

2. Jewelry Show Club

- a. When you do 25 Total Jewelry Shows within 180 days of your training show you win \$150 retail jewelry certificate
- b. When you hold 25 Jewelry Shows in any time frame you are in the Jewelry Show Club and you receive a Jewelry Show Club charm.
- c. Hold 100 Jewelry Shows (no time period) after 25 Jewelry Show Club has been achieved and receive a charm. (250, 500, 750, 1000...receive charms for each)

3. Crown Jewel Program (achieve these in order, one at a time)

- a. Amethyst: \$3000 CV in 30 consecutive day period = **\$200 retail jewelry certificate**
- b. Sapphire: \$6000CV in 60 consecutive day period = **\$400 retail jewelry certificate**
- c. Ruby: \$9000 CV in 90 consecutive day period = **\$600 retail jewelry certificate**
- d. Emerald: \$12,000 CV in 120 consecutive day period = **\$800 retail jewelry certificate**

These levels must be achieved in order and you can earn more than one!

4. Rookie Club

- a. Sponsor 2 first level jewelers and submit 12 jewelry shows within 180 days of your training show = **\$300 retail jewelry certificate**

5. Designer Program

- a. Builder – Sponsor 4 first level jewelers and submit at least 24 personal home shows/training shows/ in previous 12 months = **\$300 retail jewelry certificate**
- b. Designer – Sponsor 7 first level jewelers and submit 36 personal home shows/training shows in a previous 12 months - **\$500 retail jewelry certificate**

6. Designer's Circle – after you make Designer

- a. Sponsor 7 first level jewelers from July to June Accounting Period = **\$500 retail jewelry certificate**

Premier typically tracks these for you but it's good to know where you are in case you are very close to achieving the program – you can do whatever it takes to get there. For the Designer Program you need to complete a short orientation with your upline before you earn the jewelry certificate.
