OPENING NIGHT NECKLACE

DOUBLED





Using the Clip It, clip the necklace behind your neck so that you have two strands.

The Clip It will keep the necklace from shifting throughout your day.





Once the necklace is doubled, tie all strands in a knot – beautiful!





For a slightly more modern look, tie only one strand in the middle.

TRIPLED






Put the necklace around your neck completely opened. Cross the two strands, and using a Clip It, clip those two strands behind your neck to create a three-strand pearl necklace.







For added pizzazz, add a pin or bow – ultra feminine, dress up or dress down!

QUADRUPLED







Double the necklace in your hands, then using the Clip It, clip it together behind your neck. For fun, stagger the strands, and add a pin. You can also use a pin to clasp the necklace in the front, using the butterfly technique.

CHOKER





Double the necklace in your hands and put it on over your head. Then cross the two strands, and using the Clip It, clip it behind your neck. Note: For some ladies, clipping a few extra Clip Its together in the back will make the choker more comfortable. Or, use a bracelet or ribbon to connect it in the back. Gorgeous!

SHORT AND TWISTED









Start with the necklace doubled – hold with index fingers. Twist both ends so that the necklace twists together. Using your Clip It, clip it behind your neck. So classic! Once again, for added fun, add a pin!

LONG AND TWISTED









Using your index fingers, hold each end of the necklace and twist. Twist the necklace together until it is snug – but not too tight. Bring your index fingers together, and the necklace will automatically twist together. Use your Clip It to connect behind the neck. AWESOME!

OTHER FUN







KNOTS











Starting at one end of the necklace, create a knot. Working all the way down the strands, tie a total of 5 knots. Use your Clip It to connect it behind your neck.

COMBINING RIBBONS AND OTHER NECKLACES



Lay out a tied ribbon in a circle on a flat surface. Double the necklace, and lay in a circle on top of the ribbon.



Pull your ribbon strand from the middle of the circle of pearls, and the outside ribbon strand. Be sure your ribbon is picking up the pearls in the center of the pearl circle.






Drape the ribbon/pearl combo over your neck! Beautiful!







You can do the same technique, but this time, quadruple the pearls before you lay them on top of the ribbon strand – Gorgeous!







Again, using the same technique, use our Knot It necklace instead of a ribbon for a truly High Fashion statement necklace! Also try with The A-List necklace...begin with it unclasped and opened in a circle. Works great with other long necklaces

too!
